## Tower crane departure

The tower crane on the Stage 3 construction site will be removed this Saturday 16 May 2020.

The removal of the crane is due to commence at 6.30am and finish at approx. 5.30pm.

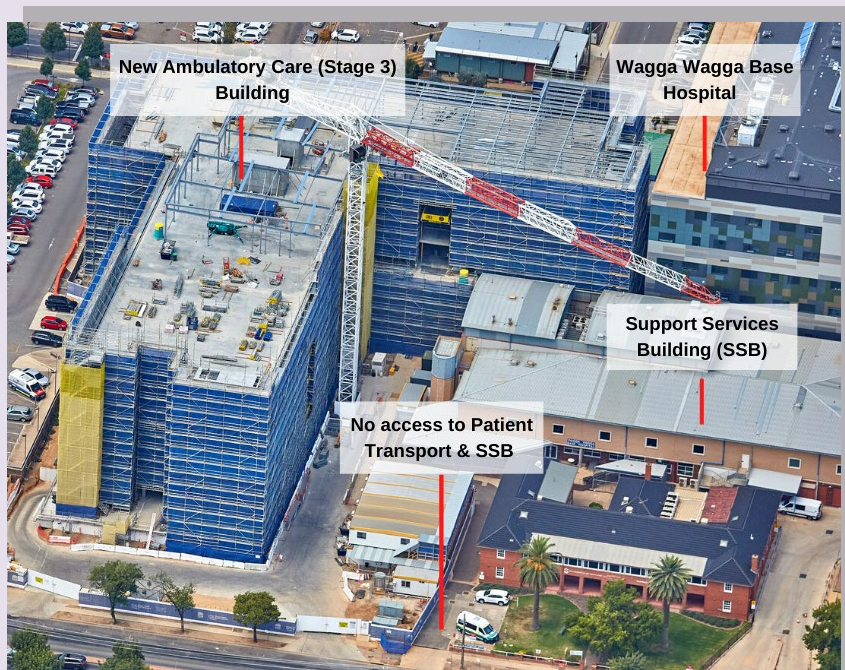
For safety reasons, there will be no access during this period to Patient Transport driveway and parking and the western entrance to the Support Services Building.

In addition to the above, pedestrians will be asked to use the opposite side of Docker Street from the health campus for 30 minutes from approx. 7.30am. Several parking spaces in front of Harvey House will be unavailable during this short period.
