Temporary relocation of Main Entry to Wagga Wagga Base Hospital

The existing Main Entry to Wagga Wagga Base Hospital will be temporarily relocated in early May 2020 as part of Stage 3 of the Wagga Wagga Health Service Redevelopment to allow for construction works to take place to the expanded Main Entry area.

This temporary entrance will remain in place until the end of the year.

The Main Entry will be temporarily relocated approx. 20 metres to the east to allow for the construction of the new Main Entry.

This work will be undertaken in a staged process to minimise disruptions to staff, visitors and patients.

Steps will be taken to ensure safety of staff and the public and we ask that you take care while accessing the main entry area.

- From **7am Monday 27 April to Friday 2 May** – contractors to prepare the temporary Main Entry area
- From **7am Monday 4 May** – new temporary Main Entry will open. There will be no change to nearby drop off bays.
- From **7am Monday 11 May to Saturday 16 May** – the construction of car park ramps, installation of in ground services, landscaping and other external works will take place. This will expand the works site requiring the relocation of some parking areas.

There will be updates and reminders of the above works as they progress over the next few weeks. Thank-you for your patience and understanding.
