RE: Wagga Wagga Health Service Redevelopment Stage 3

NSW Health Infrastructure and Murrumbidgee Local Health District (MLHD) are building a new multi-storey Ambulatory Care Building in Wagga Wagga.

It is the third and final stage of the NSW Government's \$431 million Wagga Wagga Health Service (WWHS) Redevelopment to deliver integrated and modern health services for the city and communities across MLHD.

CPB Contractors Pty Ltd has been engaged to construct the new multi-storey building on the corner of Edward and Docker streets in Wagga Wagga.

The company was granted access to the Stage 3 construction site in February 2019 when it began preparing the site for foundation work.

Construction of the new building is expected to be completed late 2020. This will be followed by a fit-out and commissioning phase in early 2021.

General construction working hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday inclusive and 7.30am to 5pm on Saturday.

On the occasion that construction works will be required outside of general construction hours, we will notify you prior to these works taking place.

Heavy vehicles will access the construction site via Docker Street and traffic control staff are on duty to direct traffic as required.

We thank-you in advance for your patience and understanding. We will continue to stay in touch and update you as construction progresses.
