NAME THE CRANE COLOURING COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. By entering the Name the Crane Colouring Competition (the Competition), an entrant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
- 1. The purpose of the Competition is to name the tower crane on the Wagga Wagga Health Service campus.
- 2. Entries are open to primary school children in Murrumbidgee Local Health District (MLHD). Child patients in the Wagga Wagga Base Hospital Paediatric Unit are eligible to enter the Competition.
- 3. The Competition is being run by MLHD.
- 4. The Competition closes at end of NSW school term 3 at 3pm, Friday 5 July 2019. After this date no further entries to the Competition will be permitted.
- 5. Winners of the Competition will be notified by telephone or email within 28 days of the closing date.
- 6. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.
- 7. Entry forms can be downloaded from the <u>Wagga Wagga Health Service Redevelopment</u> website or can be requested via email <u>WWHSR3@health.nsw.gov.au</u>
- 8. To enter the Competition, entrants must name the tower crane on the Wagga Wagga Health Service campus, colour in the crane on a downloaded entry form, complete their details including name, age, school and get signed parent/guardian permission.
- 9. Entrants must mail their completed entry forms to: Name the Crane, Wagga Wagga Base Hospital, PO Box 159, Wagga Wagga, NSW, 2650 **or** drop it at main reception, Wagga Wagga Base Hospital, 260-280 Edward Street, Wagga Wagga.
- Each entrant may only enter the Competition once. Multiple entries from the same person will be disqualified.
- 11. Prizes include the opportunity to name the tower crane on the Wagga Wagga Health Service campus, have that name displayed on the crane, attend the official crane naming ceremony, and receive a special prize.











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- 12. The **exact** prizes are as follows:
 - a. an iPad for the overall winner for best crane name.
 - b. \$50, \$30 and \$20 gift vouchers redeemable at Gateway Bookshop in Wagga Wagga for 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes for colouring the crane by children in Year 3 to Year 6.
 - c. \$50, \$30 and \$20 gift vouchers redeemable in Wombats toy shop in Wagga Wagga for 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes for colouring the crane by children in kindergarten to Year 2.
- 13. The entry must be the entrant's own original work and has not been copied from any other work.
- 14. Each entry is the property of MLHD and it has no obligation to return any entry to an entrant.
- 15. Judging will be conducted by a 3-member panel including a representative of the Wagga Wagga Health Service Redevelopment Project Team, a MLHD employee and a member of the Wagga Wagga Local Health Advisory Committee.
- 16. Entries will be judged on artistic merit given the child's age and the creativity of the crane name. The judging panel's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 17. Entries which are incomplete, incorrect, offensive, non-serious or incomprehensible will be ruled ineligible.
- 18. Any personal data relating to winners or any other entrants will be used solely in accordance with current Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998 and will not be disclosed to a third party without the entrant's prior consent.
- 19. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this Competition.
- 20. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash.
- 21. Collection of prizes will be from Wagga Wagga Health Service campus. Any transport costs or ancillary costs to attend an official crane naming ceremony at the Wagga Wagga Health Service campus are the winner's responsibility.
