New building name reflects varied health services in the District

Murrumbidgee Local Health District (MLHD) has announced the name of the new building at the centre of the third and final stage of the \$431 million Wagga Wagga Base Hospital Redevelopment.

The six-floor building will be known as the Health Services Hub to reflect its role in accommodating a wide range of public health services for communities across the District.

The Health Services Hub is connected to the Wagga Wagga Base Hospital, with links on the ground floor, levels one and four. It will accommodate approximately 60 health services including allied health, community health and ambulatory care clinics designed to service the current and future health needs of local communities in MLHD.

The Stage 3 redevelopment project also includes an undercover secure car park for fleet vehicles, additional ground level car parking and landscaping. The new BreastScreen NSW clinic, which opened in the city's central business district in 2019, was also funded as part of the Stage 3 project. Construction and operational commissioning of the Health Services Hub will be completed early this year, ahead of a staged opening.

MLHD Chief Executive Jill Ludford said: "The relocation of approximately 400 staff from 12 different sites, on the health campus and in the city, into the one building is a huge task, so the smoothest way to do this is with a staged opening of services."

The opening of the Health Services Hub in 2021 will complete the \$431 million major redevelopment of the health campus to deliver contemporary and integrated health services. It will be followed by the \$30 million multi storey car park project.

The name, Health Services Hub was selected by the District after consultation in 2020 with a committee representing staff who'll move into the new building, and members of the Wagga Wagga Local Health Advisory Committee.
