## Information session on new Ambulatory Care Building

The latest artist impressions of the new Stage 3 building as part of the \$431 million Wagga Wagga Health Service (WWHS) Redevelopment will be on display at an information session next week.

The [drop-in session for the local community and staff members will be held from 10am to 4pm, Tuesday 13 August in the Wagga Wagga Base Hospital foyer.](#)

An update on the progress of the new Ambulatory Care Building will be available from members of the Redevelopment Project Team during the information session.

Construction of the Ambulatory Care Building adjoining the Wagga Wagga Base Hospital commenced early this year, with CPB Contractors Pty Ltd awarded the contract at the end of 2018.

The work to date on the Stage 3 construction site includes the completion of foundations; excavation of basement area; installation of in ground infrastructure including hydraulic, electrical and communications services; commencement of stairwells and lift core; and the pouring of concrete for columns and ground floor slab.

Construction of the Stage 3 building is the third and final stage of the Redevelopment and is due for completion late 2020.

The NSW Government has committed \$30 million for a new car park for the Wagga Wagga Base Hospital. Construction on the multi storey car park will start following the completion of the \$431 million hospital redevelopment in 2021.
