

The \$431 million Wagga Wagga Health Service Redevelopment will provide a modern health care service suited to the current and future needs of local communities in the Murrumbidgee Local Health District.

The Redevelopment's third and final stage will deliver a new multi-storey building, known as the **Health Services Hub**, on the campus. Staff and approximately 60 health services currently on 12 separate sites on the campus and in Wagga Wagga will relocate into the Health Services Hub. Services include:
