## **RE: Wagga Wagga Health Service Redevelopment Stage 3**

Construction of the new Stage 3 building as part of the \$431 million Wagga Wagga Health Service (WWHS) Redevelopment remains on track with work underway on the forecourt, car park and entry areas.

As the construction progresses, several campus works are being undertaken in a staged manner to minimise disruptions to staff, visitors and patients.

One of the staged works includes the extension of the Stage 3 construction zone, requiring the temporary closure of the main entry car park near the front of the Wagga Wagga Base Hospital for approximately 6 months from early September 2020.

Accessible parking, drop-off zones and public parking has been re-allocated on the health campus however there may be an increased use of street parking by staff.

Staff have been reminded if they are parking in this area that is it a residential zone, and to please

- Be quiet
- Slow down
- Don't obstruct driveways
- And based on feedback we have also reminded staff not to be smoking and leaving butts on the ground.

The Stage 3 construction zone will be expanded to undertake car parking, footpath, paving and landscaping works. These works will involve a small number of trucks using Yabtree Street, Doris Roy Lane and Lewis Drive.

We thank-you in advance for your patience and understanding and apologise for any inconvenience as this important Redevelopment is completed. Construction of the new Stage 3 building is due for completion and operational commissioning in early 2021.
